



New Residential Services in Kingston



Opening in November 2011

Our housing program features nine bachelor units designed to provide accommodation and support to paroled clients living in the community but experiencing some instability; those on statutory releases **without** a residency condition, individuals with a LTSO status, and homeless ex-offenders. Our primary objective is to provide the residents with a stable and structured independent living environment as they reintegrate back into the community, and/or search for permanent housing. The average residency will be up to 6 months.

A full-time re-integration counsellor will work collaboratively with the residents, CSC, Kingston Police and other service providers to address successful reintegration measures, education and employment objectives and health-related needs.

All prospective residents must go through an application and interview process (Community Assessment Team) before being accepted to reside at the house.
